

Dear Toledo organ friends,

With my recital on Nov. 1 Trinity UCC, Tiffin is launching an effort to raise funds for work on the organ. We plan to accomplish two things:

1. Replace external leathers in the organ chambers (bellows, etc.), which are showing signs of dry-rot.
2. Upgrade the console to a solid state system.

The Schantz organ in Trinity was installed in 1969, just over 50 years ago. Some of you have played this instrument, especially if you studied at Heidelberg and worked with Dr. Catherine Thiedt, Dr. Henry Gibson, or Mrs. Dorothy Ohl. In my 20 years I've taught a handful of 'organ majors' and many non-majors and community students. This instrument has done **good service**, not only for worship in Trinity, but for instruction and performing over the years.

I would love to see some of you in the audience on Nov. 1, but I certainly recognize that we are all busy, and some are choosing to stay home while the virus is rampant. And now for the "shameless" plug...


