On November 5, Dr. Nicole Keller presented a Service Playing workshop at Christ Presbyterian Church. Denise Mathias played **With A Voice of Singing** by Martin Shaw. Dr. Keller then led us through various techniques for conducting from the console using head and hand gestures useful when conducting from the console. She also encouraged the conductor/accompanist to think about what type of sound or expression one wants from the choir and how to indicate this. Charlotte Mariasy played the hymn **Praise to the Lord, the Almighty** which led to a discussion of effective registration, phrasing, alternate harmonizations and preparation techniques. Thanks to Denise and Charlotte for playing and to Mark Mathias for hosting us. All in attendance benefitted from the various topics discussed during the workshop.
