On **November 5**, twenty members gathered for the "Adopting an Orphan Organ" program. The evening began with dinner at St. Joan of Arc, followed by a presentation by Mark Muller about the process of relocating a pipe organ. With careful consideration, a previously used pipe organ can offer an economical way for churches to acquire a pipe organ. The organ at St. Joan of Arc primarily utilized the pipework with new casework, windchests and console to compliment the sanctuary built by the Muller Co. Following a demonstration by Kevin Foos and time for others to try out the organ, the group moved to Our Lady of Lourdes Church. There a 1976 Schantz organ was incorporated into a newly built church with its original layout. Sr. Ritamarie Miller and Paul Monachino demonstrated the organ, followed by dessert served in the fellowship hall.





On **Sunday, November 28** a large, appreciative audience gathered at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Maumee as several members performed music for the Advent and Christmas season. Brad Cresswell, choir director at St. Paul, was the MC for the program. A reception followed the program. Thanks to Jane Weber for hosting, preparing the printed program, arranging rehearsal times for the organists, etc!
